Devotions – June 2012

Introduction

Today we continue looking at who Jesus Christ was and is by seeing what the writer of John's gospel had to say about him, and what Jesus had to say about himself. Today's statement is "I am the good shepherd".

The Statement

Jesus said ^{JN 10:11} "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. "I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me-- just as the Father knows me and I know the Father--and I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd.¹⁷ The reason my Father loves me is that I lay down my life--only to take it up again.¹⁸ No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down and authority to take it up again. This command I received from my Father."

The teaching

Here in Australia, we don't get the true picture of what Jesus is saying about himself. We may conjure up an image of an Australian farmer driving his sheep on horseback or on a motor bike with his dogs. He has as much attachment to his sheep as we do as consumers of the leg of lamb that his sheep is destined to become. In the time that this was written, (as in many parts of the world today) the shepherd had a much more intimate relationship with the animals under his care. He knew each of his animals and was fully responsible for the animals under his care, guiding them to good pasture during daytime, and then leading them to a safe pen for the night. Once the animals were penned in for the night, he completed their protection from attack by wild animals by lying across the entrance to the sheep pen. In the same way, Jesus loves the people in his care – that is, he knows each of his disciples and loves and cares for each one of them.

When Jesus talked about laying down his life he was talking about the death he was about to face, except that whereas the shepherd would reasonably expect to survive his action of laying down across the entrance to the pen, Jesus knew his death was certain. This also shows that Jesus was in full control of the events that lead to his crucifixion; he was not the victim of history, but the author of history. He also knew that he would rise from the dead – he had authority to both lay down his life and authority to take it up again. We don't have a specific miracle associated with this statement, but there were miraculous happenings at the time of Jesus death, and his resurrection is the greatest miracle in the whole of history.

I will conclude with perhaps the best loved of all the psalms, the 23rd Psalm. There is no doubt that Jesus was pointing to this psalm in his statement. People have been receiving comfort from the Lord for 3000 years from this psalm. Jesus is the shepherd of this psalm, even though David did not know it when he wrote it.

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.
He makes me lie down in green pastures,
He leads me beside still waters, he restores my soul.
He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,
I will fear no evil, for you are with me;
Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies.
You anoint my head with oil;
My cup overflows.
Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life
And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

May goodness and mercy follow each of us all the days of our lives, and may we all dwell in the house of the Lord forever, as we submit to the leadership and enjoy the comfort and protection of the Great Shepherd.
