# Devotions – December 2013

## Introduction

Well the season of goodwill and the end of the year are bearing down on us like an out of control freight train. As our diaries get filled to the point of overflowing I would encourage you to take some time out to reflect on the true meaning of the season. Our passage this month is my favorite passage in the whole bible. It's not normally considered as a Christmas passage, but I think that it expresses the very essence of Christmas in a very appropriate manner, and summarises what our response should be.

## *The Reading*

<sup>1</sup> If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <sup>2</sup> then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. <sup>3</sup> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.

<sup>5</sup> Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus:

<sup>6</sup> Who, being in very nature God,  
did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,

<sup>7</sup> but made himself nothing,  
taking the very nature of a servant,  
being made in human likeness.

<sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man,  
he humbled himself  
and became obedient to death--  
even death on a cross!

<sup>9</sup> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place  
and gave him the name that is above every name,

<sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,  
in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

<sup>11</sup> and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord,  
to the glory of God the Father. (NIV)

## *The teaching*

If you have ever borne a child or witnessed the birth of a child you may have been struck by the significance of the event – a new person has come into being and you have been a part of the beginning of a new life. It is a wonderful time for most people and a time of promise. Even so there is much hard work ahead and most probably a heartache or two along the way. One of the things that struck me was just how helpless and fragile babies are. The new-born baby is almost as utterly dependent on its mother as when it was in the womb and it takes years for the new person to come to a point of complete independence.

This is the path that God chose for his son Jesus when he came into the world choosing to come into this world as a man, to live the life of a human being, and to die a totally unjust death. When Jesus came into the world as a baby he was even more vulnerable than babies of our era. He was born into a Roman occupied country. He entrusted himself to the womb of a poor young Jewish lady, probably no older than in her mid-teens. His place of birth was totally unclean and uncomfortable. Because of the census imposed by the Roman occupiers and the overcrowding in the city that Mary and Joseph had been forced to travel to there was no accommodation available, and so he was born in a stable, and his bed was an animal's feeding trough. Shortly after he was born his family had to flee to Egypt as refugees. When they did return to Palestine they were probably not welcomed back to their own community because of the circumstance of Mary's pregnancy – who would believe you if you said that you were pregnant by the Holy Spirit! When he says that Jesus made himself nothing Paul was not understating the humble circumstances of his birth. As we approach the Christmas season let's not get dazzled by all the tinsel and commercial hype, but let's remember that we are celebrating the fact that God's own Son humbled himself for our sakes. May God bless you and your family this Christmas and may you know the joy of his salvation in your lives.
