Devotions – June 2013

Introduction

We continue working through Dietrich Bonhoeffer's exposition on the Sermon on the Mount in his book 'The Cost of Discipleship'. Last month we read that those who called by the grace of God to be disciples of Christ are salt and light to the communities around them. This then is the context for this month's reading.

The Reading

^{Matt 5:17}“Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. ¹⁸ For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished. ¹⁹ Therefore whoever relaxes one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do the same will be called least in the kingdom of heaven, but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven. ²⁰ For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. (ESV)

The teaching

Last month's passage may lead to the temptation for disciples (that is followers of Christ) to think that Jesus would repeal the law of the old covenant (that is the law of the Old Testament). But Jesus says “You must not imagine that I have come to destroy the law or the prophets...” And so in saying this he vindicates the authority of the law of the old covenant. So how do we understand this?

The law that Jesus refers to is the law of the old covenant, it's not a new law, but the same law that he quoted to the rich young ruler and the lawyer when they wanted to know the revealed will of God. It becomes a new law only because it is Christ who binds his followers to it. The law still demands holiness and righteousness. It is still true that no one can stand before God on the basis of their own righteousness. The Pharisees made the mistake of equating the external observance of rules and regulations with the law, and putting the law itself in the place of God. They thereby assumed that the righteousness that God demands was attainable by external actions. But the law is not itself God, nor is God the law. By their actions and attitudes, and ultimately in the call for the crucifixion of Jesus, the Pharisees and scribes proved for all time that attempting to attain righteousness through works leads not to God, but away from him and ultimately to destruction. We cannot in any way earn our way to heaven.

However there is one who has fulfilled all righteousness in his life. He did this by living in the perfect will of God, humbling himself and living a life of love and service to those that he was sent amongst, and eventually sacrificing himself to the death deserved by us all. It is this same Jesus who calls men and women to himself, to follow in his ways. In this passage Jesus calls his followers to a 'better' righteousness than that of the Pharisees. This righteousness is not of our own doing, but it is the accepting of Jesus' own righteousness that he perfected on the cross on our behalf. His righteousness is not better in degrees, but better in kind. It is perfect, but any human effort is imperfect, and it is only by Jesus' righteousness that we finite beings can have communion with the eternal infinite God of all.

Let us then accept the righteousness that Jesus Christ has obtained for us by perfectly fulfilling the law of God, and gives us by his grace, so that we may follow in his ways and enter into communion with the eternal God.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we accept and respond to your call, losing all claim to our worldly inheritance for your sake, sharing in your good works so that men will see and glorify you and in turn believe in you.
