Devotions - March 2013

Introduction

As I mentioned last month at our meeting, I have been reading firstly, a biography of Dietrich Bonhoeffer (by Eric Metaxas), and now one of his books 'The Cost of Discipleship'. The first chapter is entitled 'Costly Grace', where Bonhoeffer contrasts his conception of true discipleship with the 'cheap grace' so often found in modern churches.

The Reading

Matt 16:24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. ²⁵ For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it. ²⁶ What good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? ²⁷ For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done. ²⁸ I tell you the truth, some who are standing here will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom."

Matt 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (NIV)

The teaching

Bonhoeffer (born in 1906) was a brilliant theologian, a prophet for his times, a devoted and engaging pastor, and finally a martyr for the cause of the Gospel at the hands of the Nazis in 1945 just weeks before Germany's surrender to the Allies.

Cheap grace is the deadly enemy of our church and the destroyer of true discipleship. We are fighting today for costly grace.

Cheap grace means grace sold as a doctrine, a principle, a system. It means forgiveness of sins proclaimed as a general truth, the love of God taught as the Christian "conception" of God; that an intellectual assent to that idea is held to be of itself sufficient to secure the remission of sins. In such a Church the world finds a cheap covering for its sins; no contrition is required, still less any real desire to be delivered from sin. Cheap grace therefore amounts to a denial of the living Word of God, in fact a denial of the Incarnation of the Word of God. Cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline, Communion without confession, absolution without personal confession. Cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without Jesus Christ, living and incarnate.

By contrast, costly grace is the treasure hidden in the field; for the sake of it a man will gladly go and sell all that he has. It is the pearl of great price that the merchant will sell all his goods to buy. It is the kingly rule of Christ, for whose sake a man will pluck out the eye that causes him to stumble; it is the call of Jesus Christ at which the disciple leaves his nets and follows him.

Costly grace is the grace which must be *sought* again and again, the gift which must be *asked* for, the door at which man must *knock*.

Such grace is *costly* because it calls us to follow, and it is *grace* because it calls us to follow *Jesus Christ*. It is costly because it costs a man his life, and it is grace because it gives a man the only true life. It is costly because it condemns sin, and grace because it justifies the sinner. Above all it is *costly* because it cost God the life of his Son: "you were bought at a price," and what has cost God much cannot be cheap for us. Above all, it is *grace* because God did not reckon his Son too dear a price to pay for our life, but delivered him up for us. Costly grace is the Incarnation of God.

In our subsequent studies we will try to find a message for those troubled by the cheapening of grace, and the disastrous effects that has had on our corporate and individual lives, those for whom the word of grace has been emptied of all its meaning.
