Devotions – October 2013

Introduction

We continue working through Dietrich Bonhoeffer's exposition on the Sermon on the Mount in his book 'The Cost of Discipleship'. We have been reading of Jesus' agreement with and affirmation of the law. This month we continue with the implications of this as it applies to our relationship to our enemies.

The Reading

Matt 5:38 “You have heard that it was said, ‘An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.’ ³⁹ But I say to you, Do not resist the one who is evil. But if anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also. ⁴⁰ And if anyone would sue you and take your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. ⁴¹ And if anyone forces you to go one mile, go with him two miles. ⁴² Give to the one who begs from you, and do not refuse the one who would borrow from you. ⁴³ You have heard that it was said, ‘You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.’ ⁴⁴ But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. ⁴⁶ For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? ⁴⁷ And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? ⁴⁸ You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.” (ESV)

The teaching

As we have seen, when Jesus says “But I say to you...” we see Jesus not to be just an interpreter and guardian of the law as the scribes and Pharisees were, but to be the Author and Giver of the Law. It is only those who see Christ as the Giver and Fulfiller of the law that can attain to a true knowledge of the law, that can truly fulfil it. This month's passage looks at this in the context of our relationship to our enemies.

Here, for the first time in the Sermon on the Mount we meet the word that sums up the whole of its message, the word 'love'. Love is defined in uncompromising terms as the love of our enemies. The enemy was no mere abstraction for the disciples. They were hated for transgressing the law, for leaving everything to follow Jesus, for their weakness and humility, as prospective dangerous revolutionaries, by those who resented the exclusive claim of Christ, and so on. Even in the Old testament the people of God are not to hate their enemy, but to love them. To the natural man the very notion of loving his enemies is an intolerable offence and quite beyond his capacity – it appears quite contrary to the law of God. Jesus, however, takes the law of God in his own hands and expounds its true meaning. The will of God, to which the law gives expression, is that men should defeat their enemies by loving them.

In the New Testament, our enemies are those who harbour hostility against us – it does not even entertain the thought that we should harbour hostility against others. The Christian must treat his enemy as a brother, and return his hostility with love. By our enemies Jesus means those who are quite intractable and totally unresponsive to our love, who forgive us nothing when we forgive them all, and so on. Love asks nothing in return, but seeks those who need it. And who needs our love more than those who are consumed with hatred and are utterly devoid of love. How do we express that love?

The first part of our passage speaks of the passive endurance of evil. But Jesus goes further and asks us not only to bear with evil and the evil person patiently, but to go further – to make the same sacrifices that we would make for our brother or our lover. We are to bless those that persecute us – when they curse us we are to seek God's blessing for them (this is not to condone their evil, but it comes from a position of strength in the Lord). We are to do good to those that hate us, not only in thought and word, but also in deed – when he is hungry feed him, and so on (see Rom 12:20). We are to pray for our enemies. This is the supreme demand - we are asking God to do for them what he has done for us in Jesus, we are to plead his cause for reconciliation with God.

This is the extraordinary love that goes beyond our natural love of those who love us in return. This is the righteousness that exceeds that of the Pharisees and the scribes, it is something the followers of Jesus *do*, so that all men can see it. It is not strict adherence to rules and regulations, but simple obedience to the will of Christ. In this extraordinary love is the fulfilment of the law.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we lay down our lives by loving our enemies as you loved us in Christ whilst we were still your enemies.
