Devotions – December 2014

Introduction

Another year draws to a close and we approach what some call the 'Silly Season'. As we prepare and celebrate let's not forget the true reason for the season.

The Reading

^{Matt 1:18} Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. ²⁰ But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." ²² All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:

²³ "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel" (which means, God with us). ²⁴ When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, ²⁵ but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called his name Jesus.

^{Luke 2:1} In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. ² This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. ³ And all went to be registered, each to his own town. ⁴ And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, ⁵ to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. ⁶ And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. ⁷ And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.(ESV)

The teaching

This year we have been looking through Paul's letter to the Galatians. We have seen that there is no salvation in work, rite or ritual that we might do, but only by believing in the saving grace of Jesus Christ when he took the place we deserve by dying on the cross. We have also seen that there is no salvation for those who, having heard and received this message of grace, continue to willingly satisfy their own sinful desires, and how the Holy Spirit helps us in this battle.

In our passages today we see that this faith that we have been discussing is founded, not on human wisdom or 'a revelation' to just one person, but on a point in time historical fact. The birth (and death) of Jesus Christ is a fact attested to and accepted almost universally by secular, as well as Christian historians. In our society we see an attempt to disguise or even deny this fact in many ways, such as by the designation of date by BCE/CE that is Before Common Era and Common Era, rather than BC/AD (Before Christ and Anno Domini – In the Year of our Lord).

We also see that the one who comes into our lives to help us in the battles of life to love God, and to love our neighbour despite our own sinfulness and selfishness is the one and same Holy Spirit who conceived our Saviour and prepared his family to look after him and bring him up as a child. This is the real story of Christmas, that God's own Son came into the world to save sinners such as you and me, that he lived a real human life, he died a real human death, and God raised him to life again so that we might have an eternal relationship with him.

As we approach the Christmas season let's not get dazzled by all the tinsel and commercial hype, but let's remember that we are celebrating the fact that God's own Son humbled himself for our sakes by becoming human. May God bless you and your family this Christmas and may you know the joy of his salvation in your lives.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we see the depth of your love for us in the birth of Jesus and his death on the cross this Christmas, and also see the emptiness of our own works and worldly desires. May we and our families know your peace and goodwill this Christmas.
