Devotions – July 2014

Introduction

This year we are looking at the letter of Paul to the Galatians, the favourite letter of Martin Luther. It is an impassioned plea for Christians to remain true to the gospel of Jesus Christ, written in the context of a first century heresy, but still totally relevant in our modern world. Last month we saw that the security of the gospel lies in God's promise to Abraham and his covenant with him that was fulfilled in Christ, and that there is nothing that you or I can do, or fail to do, to change that. Our passage this month looks at the relationship that many of us already have with God, and that is available to anyone who will accept it.

The Reading

^{Gal 3:26} For in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. ²⁷ For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹

And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

^{4:1} I mean that the heir, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything, ² but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father. ³ In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world. ⁴ But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. ⁶ And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" ⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God. (ESV)

The teaching

We have already seen in this series that God offers us justification, that is to be released from the curse of our sinfulness, and that this comes by faith in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. This is a wonderful blessing that is beyond anything that this world can offer, and meets the first of our most fundamental needs as the sinners that we all are.

But this alone is not the limit of God's grace to us. For all those who are in Christ Jesus, God has adopted each one as his son (in this context a 'son' is one who is an heir – there is no connotation of gender here). Have you heard the call of God to be a forgiven follower of Jesus? Have you responded to the call and answered God to say that you want to be a forgiven follower of Christ? If so, you are in Christ – you have been baptized into him, spiritually immersed in him (Paul not talking about water baptism here, the ritual is just a simple symbol), and you have a part in his inheritance, the great promise and covenant that God made with Abraham. See that this is not a natural event, just as human adoption is not a natural event. It is a conscious decision on the part of the adopter to invite and welcome a person into his family and confer on that person all the benefits of his own family, including having a part in his inheritance. Likewise, when we are in Christ Jesus God has adopted us and welcomed us into his family – he has become our Father and we have become his heirs.

Therefore also, we are brothers and sisters with all who are in Christ. As we see in vs 28 there is no distinction here, all who are in Christ are heirs according to the promise. The Prime Minister is no better or lesser than the homeless derelict, Australia is no better or lesser than any other country, there is no superior or inferior gender. This does not mean uniformity or the removal of roles. A husband is still to be a loving leader, and a wife is still to be a loving supporter, when the Prime Minister goes to church he or she is just a member of the congregation and the pastor is still the pastor, and so on.

So whilst we still live in this fallen world, and we ourselves still fail and sin, we have the security of knowing that our inheritance is safe in God's hands, that he has a place for us when this physical body dies, and that in the meantime, he has sent the Holy Spirit to live in us and give us increasing confidence in these great truths. We are in between the terrible past of being a slave to sin and the elementary principles of this world, and the magnificent future of collecting the inheritance, but we are already heirs, waiting for the fulfillment of the inheritance. As God's children our lives could not be more secure.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we live our lives by faith in response to the promise of the inheritance that you have ready for all who are in Christ Jesus.

Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at document check.

20. CLASSES: As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code.

21. PRIZES AND TROPHIES: Points towards LBMCCC Championship
Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred. Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. ***Use of prohibited Substances***

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will apply.

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Juniors cannot take other juniors as passengers

Event 1 – consists of up to 12 tests run once each. This will determine the placings for the day

Event 2 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a knockout format. Last competitor unbeaten declared winner. This result does not count towards placings.

Trailers must be moved to the other side of the tunnel once unloaded.
