# Devotions – March 2014

## Introduction

This year we will look at the letter of Paul to the Galatians, the favourite letter of Martin Luther. It is an impassioned plea for Christians to remain true to the gospel of Jesus Christ, written in the context of a first century heresy, but still totally relevant in our modern world. This month we'll see that Paul establish his authority as an apostle.

## The Reading

Gal 1:11 For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. <sup>12</sup> For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ. <sup>13</sup> For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it. <sup>14</sup> And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers. <sup>15</sup> But when he who had set me apart before I was born, and who called me by his grace, <sup>16</sup> was pleased to reveal his Son in me, in order that I might preach him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with anyone; <sup>17</sup> nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.

<sup>2:1</sup> Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, taking Titus along with me. <sup>2</sup> I went up because of a revelation and set before them (though privately before those who seemed influential) the gospel that I proclaim among the Gentiles, in order to make sure I was not running or had not run in vain. <sup>3</sup> But even Titus, who was with me, was not forced to be circumcised, though he was a Greek. <sup>4</sup> Yet because of false brothers secretly brought in—who slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in Christ Jesus, so that they might bring us into slavery—<sup>5</sup> to them we did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might be preserved for you. <sup>6</sup> And from those who seemed to be influential (what they were makes no difference to me; God shows no partiality)—those, I say, who seemed influential added nothing to me. (ESV)

## The teaching

As we saw last week, we saw that the beginning and end of the gospel is that Jesus Christ gave himself to rescue us from bondage to this present evil age. Full Stop. There is no instruction, no secret initiation, no nothing that we can do to contribute to our salvation – it comes from God himself first and last. We also saw that there is a very strong temptation for believers to believe that we can add to our salvation by doing something extra, perhaps through some ritual, etc.

This passage explains how we can have confidence in the apostleship of Paul. He was not a self-appointed self-opinionated worker – this passage helps us to take his word seriously, to believe the promises confidently. It shows that the foundations of Christianity are excellent. We can ask questions such as “Is my faith reasonable?” “Have I done what I am meant to do in response to Christ?”. Paul is setting out the solid foundations of his ministry, his story, establishing his apostolic integrity – he shows that everything good that happened to him and through him is all is due to Christ. The message of the gospel and the message of this letter is that Christ is sufficient.

Paul received his message directly – he didn't go to classes (but we should) – Christ confronted Paul with grace and saved him. False teachers were questioning Paul's authority, saying that he begins well but that needed them to finish off the message, but Paul says he got his message from Christ and he got it complete.

The Galatians had heard what had happened to Paul, that big changes had taken place in him. His explanation is that it was God, that he was revealing Jesus in Paul. All the religion in the world cannot change the human heart, but Paul is a magnificent demonstration the Christ can and does change people. Humanity says what I have done. Faith says what Christ has done – offering forgiveness and eternal life. Christ changed the hostile person Paul. Paul's aim was to show that for all his previous plotting and scheming God had plans for his ministry, and that God himself is able to the transforming without any human aid. Paul is a demonstration of the sufficiency of Christ which is the theme of the letter.

With this solid foundation lets love the promises, lets also place ourselves under the instructions. If God has given roles at work and at home, instructions about possessions and money – lets take heed of God's word.

## Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we remain true to the gospel and live in the joy that it brings, accepting both the promises and the responsibilities that it brings.

24. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
25. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
28. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
29. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
30. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
31. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.
