Devotions – November 2014

Introduction

This year we are looking at the letter of Paul to the Galatians, the favourite letter of Martin Luther. It is an impassioned plea for Christians to remain true to the gospel of Jesus Christ, written in the context of a first century heresy, but still totally relevant in our modern world. Last month we saw the help the Holy Spirit gives us in overcoming the sinful desires of the flesh and walking by faith.

The Reading

^{Gal 6:1} Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. ² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. ³ For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. ⁴ But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbour. ⁵ For each will have to bear his own load.

⁶ Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches. ⁷ Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. ⁸ For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. ⁹ And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

¹¹ See with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. ¹² It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who would force you to be circumcised, and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. ¹³ For even those who are circumcised do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh. ¹⁴ But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. ¹⁵ For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. ¹⁶ And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.

¹⁷ From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus.

¹⁸ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen. (ESV)

The teaching

Today we come to the conclusion of our series looking through Paul's letter to the Galatians. We have seen that there is no salvation in work, rite or ritual that we might do, but only by believing in the saving grace of Jesus Christ when he took the place we deserve by dying on the cross. We have also seen that there is no salvation for those who, having heard and received this message of grace, continue to willingly satisfy their own sinful desires, and how the Holy Spirit helps us in this battle.

In vs1-5 we continue to see the work of the Holy Spirit in the life of believers in a call to spiritual team work. As we walk the Christian life we will continue to face both the temptation to trust in ourselves and our own works rather than in Christ, and the temptation to fall away into sinful license. There will be times when we succumb in this spiritual battle. When we observe someone falling into either of these traps we are called on to help restore them back on to the path of true obedience. This is to be done humbly recognising our own frailties, not with a sense of superiority. When we do so we are fulfilling the true law of Christ. If we find ourselves falling away from Christ and someone comes to us to help restore us back into fellowship with God and his people we should thank God for this and not resist it. But as we are able we need to take on the responsibility ourselves for maintaining our fellowship with God and his people.

In vs6-10 we see that we will reap what we sow. If you belong to Christ, do you sometimes wonder why you don't seem to be reaping a harvest of joy and peace in your Christian walk. If we sow to the Spirit by trusting in Christ, by doing good works and humbly helping others do likewise, if we are generous for the work of the gospel with our time, talents, money and possessions then we see that in God's good time, we will reap a harvest. On the morning of his trial before the Diet (the church parliament) where he faced the punishment of ex-communication (that is the church consigning him to hell) Martin Luther prepared by doing pastoral visiting, by seeing a person who was dying and ministering to him. He entered the court that afternoon with a smile on his face – his perspective on things was shaped by the truths in this letter.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we see the depth of his love for us on the cross, and the emptiness of our own works and worldly desires. May his grace be with all our spirits.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

Other Prohibited Substances: the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply.
