Devotions – September 2014

Introduction

This year we are looking at the the letter of Paul to the Galatians, the favourite letter of Martin Luther. It is an impassioned plea for Christians to remain true to the gospel of Jesus Christ, written in the context of a first century heresy, but still totally relevant in our modern world. Last month we saw how personally and seriously Paul took the danger that he saw his beloved Galatians falling into.

The Reading

^{Gal 5:1} For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

² Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. ³ I testify again to every man who accepts circumcision that he is obligated to keep the whole law. ⁴ You are severed from Christ, you who would be justified by the law; you have fallen away from grace. ⁵ For through the Spirit, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness. ⁶ For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love.

⁷ You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the truth? ⁸ This persuasion is not from him who calls you. ⁹ A little leaven leavens the whole lump. ¹⁰ I have confidence in the Lord that you will take no other view, and the one who is troubling you will bear the penalty, whoever he is. ¹¹ But if I, brothers, still preach circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been removed. ¹² I wish those who unsettle you would emasculate themselves!

¹³ For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. ¹⁴ For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbour as yourself." ¹⁵ But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another.(ESV)

The teaching

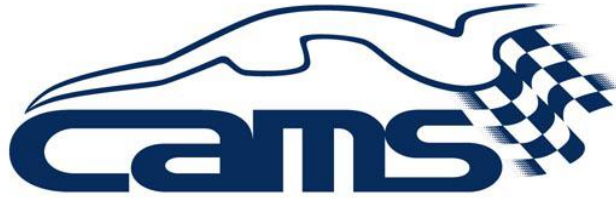
Many people are bound in visible slavery – prostitution, addictions and so on, and there are many who are bound in invisible slavery that they are aware of but are able to hide from public view such as inward anger, sadness, despair. But the worst slavery of all is to be a slave to sin – we cannot help but disobey God and there is no escape from the consequences – we are separated from God by our sin. The fundamental freedom that we have in Christ is to be free from the consequences of sin, to be free from the dread of the judgement of God. It is the freedom to know God's unconditional love in our lives, and to love others as Christ loves us knowing that whatever the outcome, whatever the cost, that we will not fall from God's grace, even when we fail, as we so often do.

In our society many people think that they are free, that they have led a 'good' life that they can 'do it themselves' and that God will accept them – it's only fair isn't it? But in vs 1-6 we see that if we decide to DIY then our DIY has to be perfect – that we have to keep the whole law of God, and that Christ will be of no advantage to us. As we are all fully aware, we know that we have not perfectly loved God or others even for a short period, never mind for our whole lives. At the end of the day we need to decide who to trust as our saviour, ourselves or Christ. It is only through the Spirit by faith that we have an enduring hope of righteousness, both now in part, and on into eternity where our righteousness will be public and perfect. In vs 7-12 we see that the Galatians have allowed themselves to be led astray, away from the safety of grace and into the trap of DIY legalism. In our day and age I suggest that the greater danger facing us is to be led astray in the other direction – that is in considering that our freedom gives us a license for self indulgence. In either case we are allowing others to lead us away from Christ. We have a decision to make as to who to follow – those who would lead us to Christ or those who would lead us away from Christ.

In vs13-15 we see that in the heart of the real Christian is a new love from Christ and a new love for Christ. Christianity is not a rule book like a dog tied to a post and it is not abandoning yourself to anything like a dog roaming the streets but it is a special freedom like a dog walking with its master enjoying freedom, provision, protection and company. When the relationship gets into us and we realise where we stand in Christ we have a real freedom of being loved by God and being able to love him in response. Even though there are remnants of sin they are not laid to our charge but pardoned for Christs sake – that is the freedom that Christ provides. We have a decision to be made as to who will be our master.

Prayer

Father, we thank you for your saving grace through Jesus Christ. May we decide who is our saviour, who will mentor us and who will be our master so that we may attain the hope of righteousness through Christ.

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence or superior and current LBMCCC Club Membership Card and Log Book (if issued) at document check.

20. **CLASSES:** As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code.
21. **PRIZES AND TROPHIES:** Points towards LBMCCC Championship
Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred.
Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.
22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. ***Use of prohibited Substances***

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A and 145B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). Other Prohibited Substances: the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply. Additionally, in any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy conflict, the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy will apply.

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.
Juniors cannot take other juniors as passengers
Event 1 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a round robin format.
Event 2 – consists of up to 6 tests run twice each. This will determine the placings for the day
Event 3 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a knockout format. Last competitor unbeaten declared winner.
This result does not count towards placings.

Trailers must be moved to the other side of the tunnel once unloaded.

Special Note: In order to be eligible for the club championship a member must officiate for at least two events in the calendar year and attend at least half of the monthly meetings.

Junior Championship:

In order to be eligible for the junior championship a member must be under the age of 18 for at least one third of the year, help out (e.g. Help cook lunch or set up courses or be a runner for the time keepers etc. (they can still compete whilst doing these)) for at least one event in the calendar year and attend at least one monthly meeting.
