Devotions – April 2015

Introduction

This year we are looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Last month we saw Paul praying for his readers (both then and now) that our faith will be strengthened by the Holy Spirit in increasing knowledge of the Supreme God. This month we see the beauty of who we are contrasted with the darkness of who we were before we were in Christ.

The Reading

^{Eph 2:1} And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ² in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— ³ among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. ⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved— ⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (ESV)

The teaching

If you have been outback on a moonless, clear night you may have been struck by the immense beauty of the stars against the intense blackness surrounding them, where the Milky Way is so bright that you have to look hard to find the Southern Cross. So it is in this passage, where the immense beauty of what God has done in Christ is contrasted against the deep bleak darkness of the human condition. In this passage we see who we were, what God has done, and who we are in Christ.

In vs 1-3 we see the intense darkness of the human condition. We were all dead in our sin – Jews, Gentiles, Aussies, everyone from the youngest to the oldest, by nature all children of God's wrath. In the most profound spiritual sense we were all dead. Like condemned men on death row, or like a person with an incurable disease there may be the appearance of life but the destiny is final and irreversible. We may have the most amazing life in this world but it is an illusion, a mask hiding our true standing for eternity. We were all rulers of our own lives and rebels against God and spiritually dead. If you have not yet put your trust in Jesus Christ, the one true source of salvation, as your own personal Saviour this passage still describes your standing with God, you are still in rebellion against Him and subject to his wrath.

In vs 4-7 we see what God has done – “But God ...”. It is he who has made us alive with Christ, it is God who has acted. Like a physical corpse we had no means by which we could resurrect ourselves – our cause was hopeless. But God in his rich mercy, because of his great love for us, even in the deadness just described in vs 1-3, has brought us to life and has made us alive. As we saw in our first study God has chosen those he wants to save – if God does not choose then there is no hope for life. Why does he choose to save some – because of his great mercy. It is he who has given us life in Christ Jesus. Not only has he saved us from his coming wrath, he has also raised us up and seated us in the heavenly places with Christ at God's right hand. It is all done, even before we have put our faith in him, by God who wants to show the immeasurable richness of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ. Vs 8-9 say the same thing. There is nothing that we can boast about, there is no place for spiritual arrogance or pride. Our faith is simply a response to what God has already done and is a demonstration of God's grace to the heavenly realms.

In vs 10 we see who we now are – we are God's workmanship to walk in the good works that he has prepared in advance for us to do, not to secure our salvation, but because we have been saved from wrath. Once we walked in trespasses and sin, but now we walk in God's good works. These good works do not save us, but they are the mark of the new creature that God has made us to be. Our response is to praise him for who he is and for what he has done.

Prayer

Father, we praise you for your amazing grace shown to us in Christ, we thank you that you have prepared good works in advance for us to do. May we walk in them, giving you all the praise and glory.

Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred. Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.
22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). Other Prohibited Substances: the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply. Additionally, in any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy conflict, the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy will apply.
