# Devotions – July 2015

## Introduction

This year we are looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Last month we saw the mystery, the message and the mission of the whole church. This month we see how the love of Christ can live in us and change us.

## The Reading

<sup>Eph 3:14</sup> For this reason I kneel before the Father, <sup>15</sup> from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name. <sup>16</sup> I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his spirit in your inner being, <sup>17</sup> so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, <sup>18</sup> may have strength, together with all the saints, to comprehend how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, <sup>19</sup> and to know this love that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

<sup>20</sup> Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all that we ask or imagine, according to the power at work within us, <sup>21</sup> to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen. (NIV)

## The teaching

As motorsport fans we find it very easy to see all the things that go wrong (why Weber could never finish a race or why missing a gear on “oh what a feeling” cost you the outright win), but we aren't so good at seeing the positives. This attitude is also very common when we think about the church.

In this passage, Paul gives us a great example of a prayer. Despite him being in prison and in a situation that could have him wallowing in misery or giving up on spreading the message of Jesus, instead he is full of hope and encouragement. What Paul prays then is still relevant for all Christians now.

The first thing that Paul prays is that Christ will infiltrate our lives, that he will dwell in us and change us to be more like him. When we first acknowledge our sinfulness and ask God to forgive us, the Spirit moves into our lives. But what Paul is asking for here is that Christ will permeate every fibre of our being and every aspect of our lives. This change will not necessarily happen instantly. It is a process that happens as we allow God to take control of our lives. We see in verse 16 that this is all happening with God's power, not ours. God is a rich and powerful father who generously strengthens us to let Christ infiltrate our lives.

The second thing that Paul is praying is that we will have an expanding appreciation for the love of Christ. For many of us, when we are faced with generosity or offered a gift, our natural reaction is to be suspicious or to run away. But here we see that we need to once again call on the strength of our Heavenly Father to not only accept the gift of being adopted into His family through Jesus' death and resurrection, but to increasingly understand just how enormous a gift this is. The love of Christ is so vast that it is beyond our comprehension.

It is this grasp of how miraculous and generous the love of God is that keeps Paul going with his work while he is in prison. And the same applies for us. As we fall into a habit of focusing on all the things that are wrong with our experiences at church, we should pray that God will give us the strength to see and understand the depth of his love for us and to respond appropriately.

Why should we ask this of God? So that we as Christians can draw on the enormous power of God rather than trying to do it on our own. And in so doing bring glory to the God who has rescued us from being “dead in our sins” (2v1) and has “adopted us as through Jesus Christ” (1v5). Just as calling 000 doesn't take long but brings to us huge resources, so praying a prayer like this doesn't take long but brings with it resources beyond anything we can ever imagine.

## Prayer

Father, we pray that you will strengthen us to allow Jesus to infiltrate every part of our lives. And we pray that we may continue to grow in our understanding of how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Jesus our saviour.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. ***Use of prohibited Substances***

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will apply

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Juniors cannot take other juniors as passengers

Event 1 – consists of up to 12 tests run once each. This will determine the placings for the day
