Devotions – March 2015

Introduction

This year we are looking at Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Last month we saw how the three persons of the Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit are working together for our salvation, and that this is ultimately to the praise of God's glory. This month we see Paul praying for his readers (both then and now) that our faith will be strengthened by the Holy Spirit in increasing knowledge of the Supreme God.

The Reading

^{Eph 1:15} For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, ¹⁶ I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, ¹⁸ having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might ²⁰ that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. ²² And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, ²³ which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all. (ESV)

The teaching

Paul's prayer for us is for our knowledge of God to grow by the Spirit enlightening us. That is we need to seek the Spirit's help to bring our knowledge of God to fruition in true faith. His prayer is in 3 parts (vs18-19): that we may know the hope to which we have been called in Christ, to know our value as his inheritance in Christ, and to know his immeasurable power toward us in Christ.

The hope of our calling looks back to having been chosen by God, not because we are great, but because God is gracious, and that this is all to the praise of his glory. Our hope is of our future eternal fellowship with God which is based on what he has already accomplished in Christ – that is our salvation at his expense on the cross, and which is attested to by his resurrection and ascension to God's right hand. This is not an uncertain expectation, but a firm conviction because it doesn't depend on what we may or may not have done, but only on what God has already done for us.

As we saw last time we have been adopted as his sons (where sonship signifies entitlement to an inheritance). When we are in Christ we are his body, and he is our head, we share in his inheritance, and we have the Spirit as the guarantee of that inheritance. But there is more, we will become his inheritance, his treasured possession, and as such we are very valuable to him. Paul's prayer is that believers will know that we matter to God. Do you ever wonder if God takes a personal interest in you? He continues to love us right now with all our hurts, cares and joys. It is a love grounded in his grand plan for establishing his glory, and it means wonderful things for us, blessings now even in the midst of trials and troubles, but much more as God brings all things in subjection to Christ at the end of time – all for the praise of his glory.

What does it mean to know the immeasurable power toward us who believe? There are two universal fears held by mankind throughout the ages – the fear of how to deal with the consequences of our sins and failings at the end or time, and the fear of eternal spiritual death, which as Christians we understand to mean eternal separation from God. These fears demonstrate the importance of the resurrection and ascension of Jesus Christ to God's right hand. They show that Christ has power over sin and death and the spiritual realm – he has conquered all other powers and he sits in the seat of supreme authority at God's right hand. And we the church are his body, and share in the power that he has over all realms. Ultimately no other powers can hold sway over us as they are all subject to him. He has conquered every enemy and we share in that victory.

Prayer

Father, may the Spirit enlighten our hearts to know the hope that we have been called to, the riches of his glorious inheritance, and the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us as believers, so that our lives may be to the praise of your glory.

Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled. Competitors must produce a valid and current CAMS Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at document check.

20. CLASSES: As per Article 7 of the National Motorkhana Code.

21. PRIZES AND TROPHIES: Points towards LBMCCC Championship
Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, including penalties incurred. Penalties shall be in accordance with Article 17 of the National Motorkhana Code.

22. The C.A.M.S. permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

25. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.

26. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior. (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.

27. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.

28. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

30. **Use of prohibited Substances**

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will apply

31. A passenger may be carried in a vehicle while competing in a Motorkhana as described in 19.1 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Juniors cannot take other juniors as passengers

Event 1 – consists of up to 12 tests run once each. This will determine the placings for the day

Event 2 – consists of two identical tests run simultaneously as a knockout format. Last competitor unbeaten declared winner.

This result does not count towards placings.

Trailers must be moved to the other side of the tunnel once unloaded.
