Devotions – April 2017

Introduction

Our series this year entitled “The Word that changed the World”, is looking at how Jesus was at work in the early church and what that means for us in the twenty-first century. Today we take a little break to mark the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. Our Protestant faith owes everything to the work that God did through the people who brought about this revolution in the church.

The Reading

Galatians 3:1-9 ¹ O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. ² Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? ³ Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? ⁴ Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? ⁵ Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith— ⁶ just as Abraham “believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness”? ⁷ Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. ⁸ And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, “In you shall all the nations be blessed.” ⁹ So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. (ESV)

The teaching

Five hundred years ago this year Martin Luther pinned his 95 Theses to the church door in Wittenburg in Germany. Whilst the book of Romans provided the rigorous foundation for Luther’s work, his favourite scripture was the book of Galatians, to the point that he described it as his second wife. Our reading today comes from this book. By the time of the 16th century, the Catholic church was utterly corrupt and had departed so far from biblical faith that it was unrecognisable as the church of Christ. The 95 Theses refuted many aspects of Catholic theology and practice, and were the catalyst for a cataclysmic shift, not just in the church but in all of German society. It sparked similar movements across Europe, and was carried forward by people such as William Tyndale and Thomas Cranmer in England, Huldrych Zwingli in Switzerland, John Knox in Scotland and John Calvin in France. In particular, the belief that the Scriptures were the authoritative Word of God drove many of the reformers to translate the Scriptures into the common tongue, in direct contravention of church law. Many of these people and other reformers (who in practice were really missionaries) paid for their stand for the truth with their lives.

One of the clearest summaries of the doctrinal issues that were at stake in the Reformation is the slogan coined by Martin Luther to describe his position: *sola gratia* (by grace alone), *sola Christi* (by Christ alone), *sola Scriptura* (by Scripture alone), *sola fide* (by faith alone). In essence, these Latin phrases were Luther's answer to four basic questions:

How can a person be right with God? *Sola gratia* (by grace alone). The only way that sinful human beings can come back into a right relationship with God is through God's initiative alone. It is not because some of us are more deserving, or have earned his favour. God freely and graciously saves those who cannot save themselves. It is all from God.

How does this grace come? *Sola Christi* (by Christ alone). God chooses to be gracious to us in a particular way, through a particular channel – through Jesus Christ. His generosity and kindness to us is mediated not through priests or rituals or religion or anything else, but through Christ alone, and in particular through his death and resurrection.

How do we find Christ? *Sola Scriptura* (through Scripture alone). Against those who would say that Christ is to be found through mystical experience, or through the authoritative teaching of the church, Luther argued that Scripture alone is the one, true place where Christ's voice is heard.

What is our part? *Sola fide* (by faith alone). Our response to God's grace in Christ that is found in Scripture is faith – that is, a personal trust in God, that what he has promised to do for us in Christ he will do. This glad trust in God then results in a changed way of living. Luther put it like this: "Faith is a living and unshakeable confidence, a belief in the grace of God so assured that a man would die a thousand deaths for its sake. This kind of confidence in God's grace, this sort of knowledge of it, makes us joyful, high-spirited, and eager in our relations with God and with all mankind. This is what the Holy Spirit effects through faith. Hence the man of faith, without being driven, willingly and gladly seeks to do good to everyone, serve everyone, suffer all kinds of hardships, for the sake of the love and the glory of the God who has shown him such grace."

These four foundational doctrines of the Reformation, which we have summarized only briefly, had enormous implications. It was because of these beliefs that the Reformers knew they could no longer remain within the Roman Catholic church. Unlike Erasmus, they were not content merely to call the church back to be more faithful to its existing doctrine. The Reformers were convinced that the Roman church had departed from biblical Christianity at these crucial points. (extracted from *The Essence of the Reformation* by Kirsten Birkett).

This Easter, as we remember Jesus Christ’s death on the cross and his resurrection, let us reflect on these four wonderful aspects of our faith and give all praise and thanksgiving to God, firstly for the apostles who carried this teaching to all parts of the ancient world, and then for the reformers who brought these truths back to life 500 years ago at great personal cost, to re-establish the one true church of Jesus Christ.

Prayer

Father, by your grace may we accept the wonderful gift of forgiveness made possible by Jesus’ death and resurrection as you have revealed to us through the scriptures. May we respond in faith to your calling in thankful obedience through holy living and good works that bring glory and praise to your name.
